Black Pine Animal Sanctuary Part-Time Veterinarian

Black Pine Animal Sanctuary is a nonprofit 501c3 exotic animal sanctuary in Albion, Indiana. We are the only multi species sanctuary in the Midwest and the only GFAS (Global Federation of Animal Sanctuaries) accredited sanctuary in Indiana. The roughly 80 animals who live at the sanctuary, have been surrendered or confiscated by legal authorities and will remain at Black Pine Animal Sanctuary, living peacefully and being well cared for, for the rest of their lives.

Overview:

The part-time veterinarian will provide care for roughly 80 animals including carnivores, birds, reptiles, primates, and hoof stock. This position will work closely with the licensed veterinary technician in the oversight and execution of the animal health program.

Duties:

- *Provides clinical care including but not limited to: examinations, surgery, diagnostics, treatments, lab work interpretation, disease surveillance, pathology and necropsies at the on-site veterinary hospital.
- *Ability to assume primary vet role in immobilizing various species of animals including carnivores, primates, birds, reptiles and hoof stock.
- *Coordinates and implements the animal health program: quarantine, parasite control, vaccine program and infectious disease testing.
- *Complies with DEA and State Regulations for ordering and maintaining controlled drugs.
- *Provides guidance to animal care staff in animal nutrition and zoonosis.
- *Coordinates with outside specialist
- *Works directly with licensed veterinary technician and animal care staff.

Requirements:

- *Holds a Veterinary Degree from accredited School of Veterinary Medicine
- *License to practice in the state of Indiana
- *Experience with exotic species (primates and large carnivores is required)
