

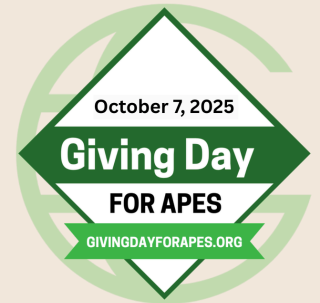
# 2025 Impact Snapshot

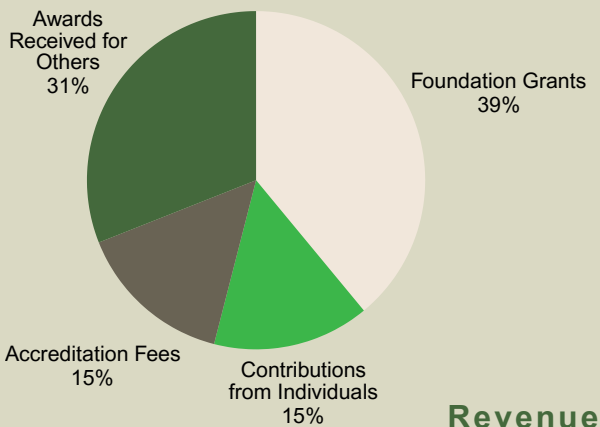

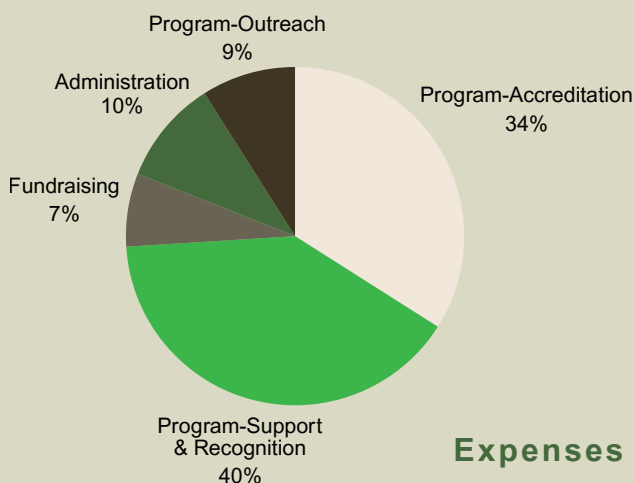
## Carole Noon Awardee for Sanctuary Excellence
